

Can fiberglass tails be flattened



Overview

That area must be flattened before fiberglass is applied. Does the boat have an outer keel or skeg?

If the bottom has a vee, the area will need to be. you can do a “V” cut, with the point of the v facing the tips of the swallows. if that dont make since then try this: before you wet anything out, fold the lap under with your hand by the tail. you can easily see the excess glass poking out the oppisite sides of the tail. that excess is what you. For jobs requiring narrow strips of fiberglass, cutting tape strips cleanly, from a single large fiberglass roll, can save the expense of buying smaller rolls of fiberglass tape. First, find sharp scissors or a fabric wheel cutter, a flat table and a well-lit workroom. It will prevent cracking and splitting.

First, find sharp scissors or a fabric wheel cutter, a flat table and a well-lit workroom. Lay the fiberglass flat on a table and locate a single fiberglass strand that runs all the way across the fabric.



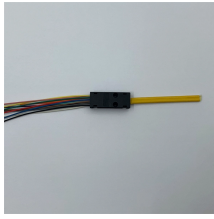
FAQ: 1.) How can I void "splintering" the fiberglass when cutting? Answer: There are a couple ways. The easiest way is to wrap the area to be cut with masking tape before the cut is made. With the masking ...



That area must be flattened before fiberglass is applied. Otherwise, you will need to cut into the fiberglass; drill the hole and fit the bow eye before fiberglassing.



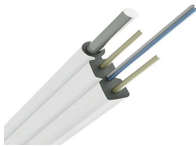
I stretch that down directly over the corner first after its wetted out and squeegee it flat. Sometimes I'll use my finger tip to do that in order to get the coverage as clean as possible.



This morning when i came out in the garage i noticed some dry cloth or blisters near the tail where the cloth wraps around the sharp railedge. These blisters are small but i think i'll try and fill ...



Working with fiberglass is easy when you have the right tools and understand the basic techniques of working with this amazing material.



Mounting surface of the whale tail will have to be trimmed to match the contour of the sleeper roof.



You can use an autobody product called "kitty hair" or "tiger hair" that is a water proof resin with chopped glass mixed in. Cheaper and easier to use than fiberglass mat when working in ...



Here''s a little better drawing about how to sand fiberglass empennage tips for a good fit. Just make up a right angle sanding block from plywood, press board or whatever you have handy.

It isn't too hard, and there are several ways to do it. What I am going to tell you is get a good respirator and use it. The chemicals are strong, and ground fiberglass is not good to breathe. At the minimum ...



You should only need one on each end for a rounded nose / tail. Just cut straight down the middle in line with the stringer by no more than 1/2" past the nose/tail onto the board then cut a ...

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
