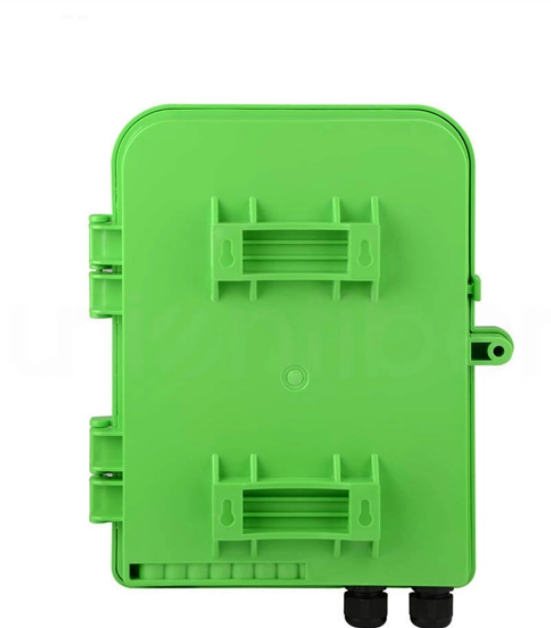


Core Switch Failure

We have a pair of Dell N3224P-ON switches and today's morning my colleague gave me a task and instructions to remove some unused VLANs. I'm sure I removed the correct VLANs. When I saved the configuration, everything stopped working and now we don't know what to do. We already rebooted both. The problem of switch failure generally includes physical layer failure, port negotiation and self-loop issues, Vlan issues, device compatibility issues, and other problems. Its primary function is to rapidly forward data packets between different aggregation switches and, ultimately, to the internet.

The line comes into the server room in upper floor and the network core switch in upper floor connects to fiber core switch in lower floor. So, there are two points of failover: one is the core ...



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So when one of the "new core" switches goes down, anything connected to it will still be offline. You can design around this by having redundant connections to the different "cores" and letting STP handle ...



We have a Huawei Core switch and a Dlink plug and play switch before the new Huawei Access switch was deployed. I discovered that everyone on the Core Switch and Dlink Switch is all ...



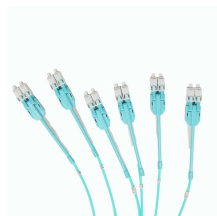
Hi, if the switch run for about five minutes and then it turns off could be overheating. If you have SNMP logging setup check the snmp temperture logs and see, also could be a bug in the system.



Unlike access switches, which connect directly to end-user devices, the core switch focuses on aggregating and routing traffic between other switches, minimizing latency and ...



The solution to reviving this core switch was unbelievable. Let's take a closer look at the infrastructure and the troubleshooting case.
