

Does a 30-meter cable tray need to be grounded



Overview

All metallic cable trays must be grounded as outlined in NEC Article 250. This precaution helps prevent electrical shocks and equipment malfunctions. Cable tray may be used as the Equipment Grounding Conductor (EGC) in any installation where qualified persons will service the installed cable tray system. The metal in cable trays may be used as the EGC as per the limitations. It is essential that the grounding of cable tray systems, including the cables in the tray systems, is inspected for compliance with the grounding requirements in the National Electrical Code (NEC) BEFORE the cabling in the tray is energized and BEFORE cable is installed. Grounding and bonding are mandatory for metallic trays. When the connection is very close, and the meter indicates a low resistance.



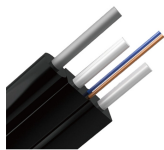
