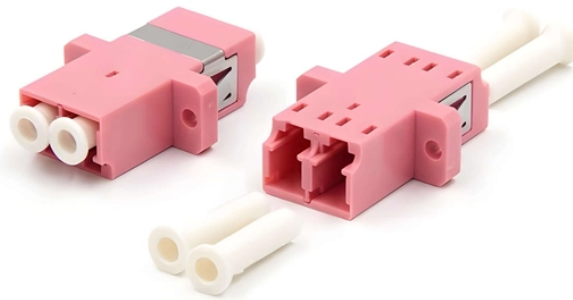


## How to attach wall covering to a distribution box

The plate must completely cover the opening and attach directly to the box or a plaster ring using machine screws. The screw holes on the blank plate align with the mounting ears or tabs on the electrical box, creating a secure, closed enclosure. 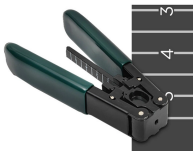

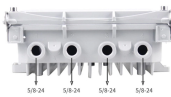

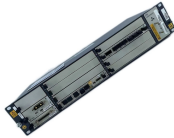
