Illuminometers quantify the brightness of a lit surface by measuring luminous flux per unit of area. (The JIS C 1609-1 standard. 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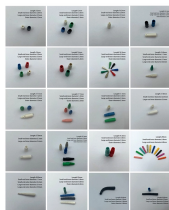
