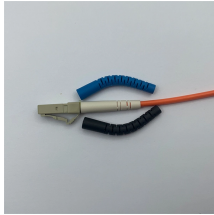
Wiring arrangement: Arrange the wires neatly in the box, fix them with zip ties, avoid wires from tangling or coming into contact with sharp edges, and reserve a certain amount of space ...



With a 4-sq box I don't fold the wires into it, I wrap them around the inside perimeter. This seems to use the space most efficiently and leaves the center open for the device.



You can definitely do this with all 3 wires, and I regularly terminate wires this way when the wires are already in the box with about 6" of wire left in the box.
