

Iran has good core switch technology



Overview

As anti-government protests over a deepening economic crisis enter the third week in Iran, the country has used a 'kill switch' approach to jam Elon Musk's Starlink satellite internet service to suppress and control communication flow. When Iran's authorities enacted a sweeping nationwide internet blackout and, for the first time, deliberately targeted and neutralized Starlink satellite connectivity, they did more than silence a population — they crossed a strategic threshold in the architecture of modern authoritarian control.
