Overview

Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. 26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used. The neutral conductor is typically the grounded conductor connected to the system's neutral point, carrying current under normal operation. You can mount the chassis with either. Our terminal boxes have been designed to offer an easy, fast and reliable solution for core and frame grounding as well as connecting CT wires inside the transformer to external measuring/monitoring systems.

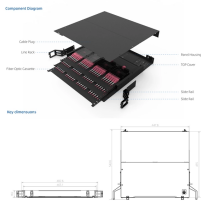
