

Lebanon receives fiber optic cable



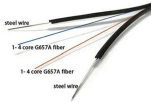
Overview

Telecommunications Minister Charles Hajj announced this week the resumption of the country's fiber-optic internet rollout after years of stalling caused by the onset of the economic crisis in 2019 and, more recently, by the war between Israel and Hezbollah. More than 325,000 households will benefit from this rollout, which is expected to be completed within 16 to 24 months, according to the telecommunications minister and Ogero. The project, announced during a launch event held at the Grand Serail last February, consists of replacing Lebanon's outdated copper wire infrastructure with fiber optic cables.



As fiber optic cables are able to carry much more data than copper cables, especially over long distances, copper telephone networks built in the 20th century are being replaced by fiber.



Once completed in 2020, the network promises to bring speeds of at least 50 megabits per second to the vast majority of Lebanese internet users - more than 10 times faster than many ...
