

## Lifespan of pigtail



### Overview

Its name comes from its short, half-erect tails that resemble a pig's tail. These macaques are 47-60 cm long on average and weigh 4. They can live up to 26 years in the wild and 35 years in captivity. Pigtail macaques are sexually dimorphic with males measuring 495 to 564 mm (1. Temperatures change seasonally and vary. The southern pig-tailed macaque, also known as the Sundaland pig-tailed macaque and Sunda pig-tailed macaque, is a medium-sized macaque found in rainforests up to 2,000 meters (6,600 ft) in Northeastern India, Burma, Thailand, Sumatra, Borneo, and the Malayan Peninsula. A trained male monkey is able to pick about 1000-1500 coconuts a day, while a female monkey still collects about 600 coconuts a day! How do you recognize a healthy monkey?

The average lifespan of a monkey is very lengthy, ranging from 15-20 years for marmosets (also known as finger monkeys or marmosets) to up to 45 years for Capuchin.



Pigtail macaques live in the wild is up to 30 years, with the average lifespan in the wild being estimated at 26 years. Their lifespan in captivity is up 34.3 years.



Pigtail macaques have an abbreviated tail, less than the length of the body from head to rump, often bare or covered only by sparse fur. They move quadrupedally on the ground and through ...



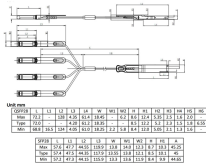
Pigtail macaques have an expected lifespan of about 26 years in the wild if they survive to sexual maturity. Captive individuals have lived up to almost 35 years.
