

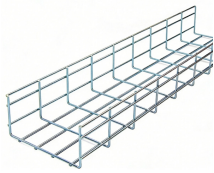
Ranking of local optical modules in Gabon



Overview

In 2024, Gabon imported Optical fibres and cables primarily from: China (\$1.8M), France (\$610k), Morocco (\$33.69k), and Turkey. Market Forecast By Component (Laser, Photodiode, 1xn Photonic Switch, Sub module, Controller, Display, Operator, Others), By Monitoring Type (Active Fiber Monitoring, Dark Fiber Monitoring), By Technology (Distributed Acoustic Sensing, Distributed Temperature Sensing, Real Time Thermal Rating). In 2024, Gabon exported \$326 of Optical fibres and cables, making it the 154th largest exporter of Optical fibres and cables (out of 167) in the world. The FDI quantifies and ranks the level of investment in fiber optical networks across nine metrics on a country-level basis. 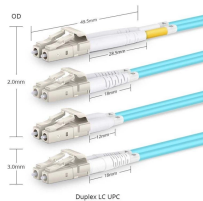
