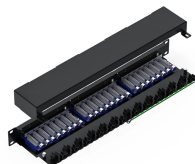

To date, fiber optic networks have been deployed in parts of Somaliland, Puntland, and in the Mogadishu metropolitan area.



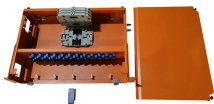
