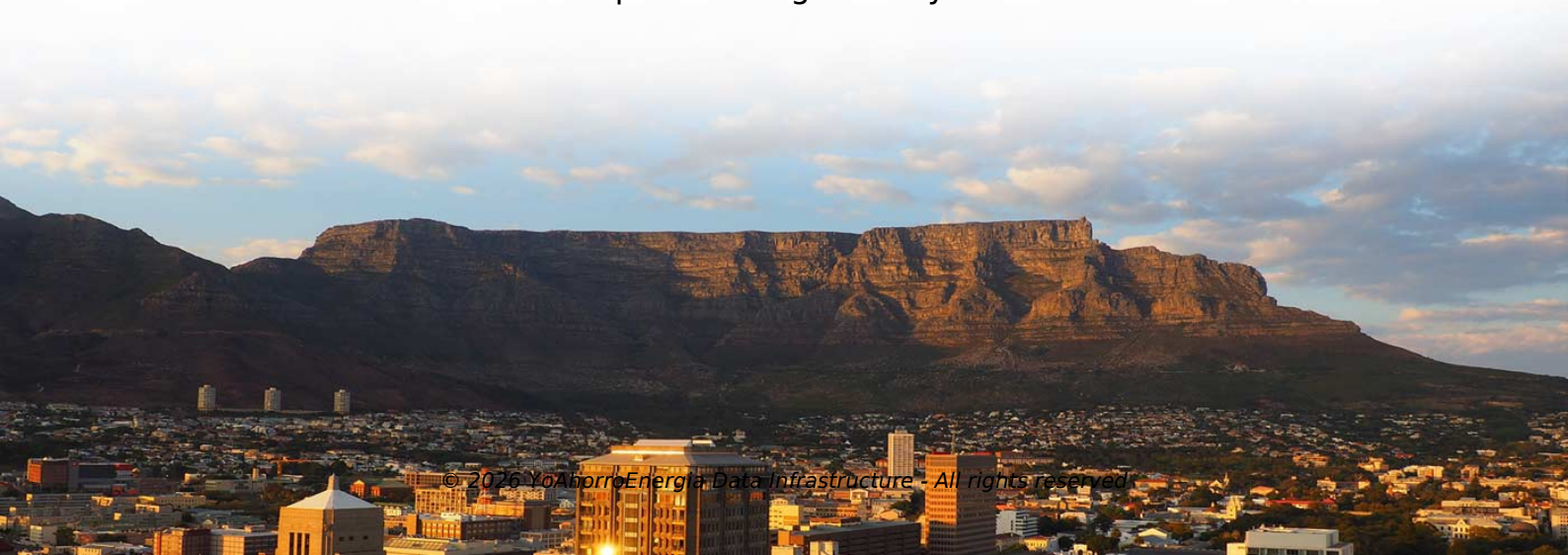


What does an optical fiber distribution system include



Overview

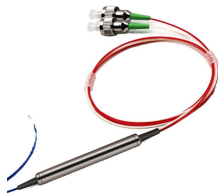

As data centers, enterprises, telecom operators, and smart-building infrastructures deploy increasingly dense fiber links, ODFs provide the structured. While the OLT manages the signal and the ONU converts it at the user end, the ODN is the passive infrastructure that carries the optical signal efficiently, reliably, and cost-effectively from the OLT to multiple end-users. This means it does not need power along the way.

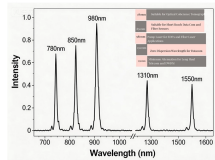
