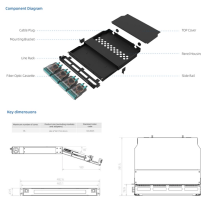

The technique involves using thin needles to stir ground coffee inside the portafilter before tamping, breaking up clumps and distributing grounds evenly. It breaks up clumps and eliminates channels, resulting in more balanced extraction and significantly improved espresso flavor profiles.
