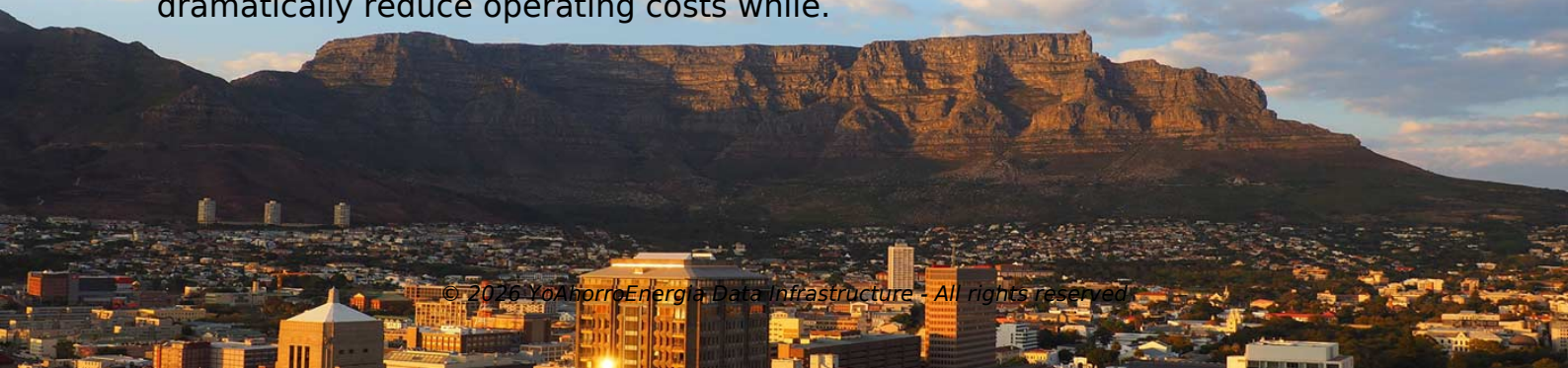

Which is better — hot or cold aisle?

HAC often yields better PUE improvements, but CAC is easier to retrofit in some facilities. How much energy can aisle containment save?

Anywhere from 10% to 43% in cooling energy, with ROI payback between. Hot aisle and cold aisle containment are foundational concepts in data center design. When implemented correctly, they improve efficiency, reduce energy consumption, extend equipment life, and enhance overall reliability. Data centers with air-cooled systems looking to isolate hot zones for better. The system simply aligns server fronts (air intakes) toward a shared cold aisle, and backs (exhausts) toward a shared hot aisle. Cold Aisle: Rows of racks face each other, forming a corridor where cool air is directed. The right choice can dramatically reduce operating costs while.

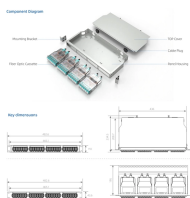
In this layout, server racks are arranged in alternating rows, with the fronts of servers facing each other (Cold Aisles) and the backs facing each other (Hot Aisles).

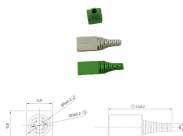
